Dear Parents,

We are happy to announce we are offering summer camp this summer. Children are accepted who have competed kindergarten through grade five. Your child's health and safety are our top priority. We are going to be following the CDC recommendations for summer camp programs and operational strategy for K-12 Schools. Masks are optional and we will also do as many activities outdoors as possible.

Our dress code is modest, comfortable clothing, so the children can be cool and comfortable while participating in camp activities. All girls will need a ONE-PIECE swimsuit for weekly swimming trips and water play. Athletic shoes with light-colored soles, no black soles, should be worn at all times. No sandals or flip-flops can be worn due to safety concerns. Campers will be asked to bring their own lunch, drink, and water bottle daily. A small insulated box/bag is a must for keeping lunches cold in warm weather. Pizza lunch will be provided on Thursdays.

Payment is expected on the **MONDAY FOR EACH WEEK**. If payment for the previous week has not been paid, you will be asked not to bring your camper the next day. You will not be charged during your vacation (maximum of two weeks), as long as we have a Vacation Request Form each absence. We will not prorate your weekly tuition for vacations. When vacation is taken during spilt weeks, (Thursday-Friday or Monday-Wednesday) we will give the week starting your vacation as the no charge vacation week. A full week's tuition will be charged the week your vacation ends. You will not be charged for a prolonged illness of a week or more as long as we have a written notice. If your child must quarantine due to Covid you will not be charged. If your child is absent three days or more during a week of camp for any reason (excluding your vacation week), you will be charged for the whole week of camp. Checks should be made payable to TGCA. **Campers attending three or more days will be charged the full week.**

All payments must be paid in the business office. Cash, Check, or Credit cards will be accepted.

A late fee will be charged if your child is not picked up by 5:30pm.

Activities
